## SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (Besom Lane, Westerleigh) (No.2) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Foot Passengers, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Besom Lane which extends from its junction with Westerleigh Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 900 metres.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon Openreach overhead cabling works on or adjacent to the highway. The order will be operative from 14 December 2023 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of a **1 day** duration, between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm.
