The above order, made on 1 May 2024, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that length of public footpath LDO 19 in the Unitary District of South Gloucestershire in the Parish of Dodington from the farm access track south of the stream at **Point A** (grid reference ST 7308 7829) running in a south-southwesterly direction across a field then into the middle of the farm buildings for a distance of 279 metres to meet LDO 20 at Point D (grid reference ST 7297 7804) then continuing in a southerly direction through farm buildings and along a field edge for a distance of 244 metres to meet LDH 8 near the field boundary north of the River Boyd and M4 motorway at Point B (grid reference ST 7295 7779). Shown by a bold continuous line marked A - D - B on the map contained in this order; that length of public footpath LDO 20 in the Unitary District of South Gloucestershire in the Parish of Dodington from the unaffected part of the path at the field edge south of two ponds at Point C (grid reference ST 7270 7829) running in a southeasterly direction across a field, through a field boundary and into the centre of the farm buildings for a distance of 379 metres to meet LDO 19 at Point D (grid reference ST 7297 7804). Shown by a bold continuous line marked C - D on the map contained in this order; and that length of public footpath LDH 8 in the Unitary District of South Gloucestershire in the Parish of Dodington from where it meets LDO19 north of the River Boyd and M4 motorway at **Point B** (grid reference ST 7295 7779), running in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres, crossing the river and then continuing in an easterly direction between the river and the motorway before crossing the river again, for a distance of 280 metres to the unaffected part of the path in the corner of the field at **Point E** (grid reference ST 7323 7778). Shown by a bold continuous line marked **B** – **E** on the map contained in this order -

to a line running from LDH 19: From the farm access track south of the stream at Point A (grid reference ST 7308 7829) running in a southeasterly direction across an agricultural field for a distance of 392 metres to the field boundary at Point G (grid reference ST 7328 7796) then following an unmade track through a field in a southeasterly direction for 53 metres and turning within the field at Point H (grid reference ST 7331 7792) to follow the hedge alongside the River Boyd in a southwesterly direction and for a distance of 171 metres to meet LDH 8 at the field boundary close to the M4 motorway at Point J (grid reference ST 7322 7779). Having a total length of 616 metres, a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked A - G - H - J on the map contained in this order; LDH 20: From the field edge south of two ponds at Point C (grid reference ST 7270 7829) running in an easterly direction across an agricultural field for a distance of 386 metres to the surfaced farm track north of the stream at **Point F** (grid reference ST 7308 7831). Having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked **C** - **F** on the order map; and **LDH 8**: From the field boundary at the River Boyd, Point J (grid reference ST 7322 7779) running in a generally southeasterly direction for a distance of 17 metres to the corner of the field alongside the motorway to meet the unaffected part of the path at Point E (grid reference ST 7323 7778). Having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked **J – E** on the order map.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
